### MONDAY

Nature Connections: Introduction to the Coastal Sage Scrub Community and native use of plants for medicines, food, Indian rope and basket weaving.

### TUESDAY

Awareness and Senses: Opening our senses to increase awareness of the nature in our every day experiences. Walking like a Native; touching earth and painting a rock, making a soapstone bead.

### WEDNESDAY

Inspiration, Exploration, and Focus - A chance for each child to find a secret spot and to explore and deeply connect with the rhythms of nature singing Acjachemen songs with clapper sticks and watching a Native American dancer.

### THURSDAY

Human Impact on the Environment- A day to examine our footprint on the planet and how we can preserve, protect, and enhance the wilderness- Learn about how the Juaneno People only took what they needed and were careful to let nature be. Hearing the words of Chief Seattle and creating nature poems too!

### FRIDAY

Integration and reflection- a final hike ( 3 miles) in the park exploring all of our new talents for understanding nature. Like a native vision quest a test of our mental and physical abilities. Make an arrowhead and use the pumpdrill for boring a hole in a shell for a necklace. We are all connected to the web of life!

### Staging Area Driving Directions

#### From the 405 freeway

- From the 405 freeway go south on Highway 133 (Laguna Canyon Road)
- Continue south on Laguna Canyon Road approximately 5 miles
- Turn right into the LCWP Willow Staging Area

#### From the 73 Toll Road

- From the 73 Toll Road exit Laguna Canyon Road and go south
- The LCWP Willow Staging Area is on the west (right) side of the road approximately 0.8 miles from the 73 Toll Road

#### From Pacific Coast Highway (PCH)

- From PCH go north on Broadway Street
- Broadway Street turns into Laguna Canyon Road
- Continue north on Laguna Canyon Road for approximately 3.2 miles
- The LCWP Willow Staging Area is on the west (left) side of Laguna Canyon Road
